The facility contained a complete kitchen to service the cafeteria and indoor and outdoor dining area. The building contained two large atriums with skylights and housed offices, electronic laboratories, and a 12,000 square-foot laboratory to simulate under C

fiber optic testing. The facility and GBA received the Boma, NJ 1999 TOBY (Top Office Building of the Year) Award for Corporate Facility.

Completed in record time, Tyco Submarine Systems, Ltd. at 250 Industrial Way West, Eatontown, New Jersey is a custom-built, state-of-the-art, technologically advanced Research and Development Laboratory.

The new home of TSSI - a leader in undersea fiber optic technology - allows all laboratory districts to be under one roof.

Conveniently situated just one mile from the Garden State Parkway and a half of a mile from State Highway #35, this two story, 138,000 square foot building was constructed in 1998. The striking exterior is clad in a complimentary blend of granite, tinted glass and EIFS. A cylindrical-columned two story entranceway greets both employees and visitors to the complex.

A distinguished vaulted atrium is flattered by large pyramidal skylights creating an open, nature-like environment. Unique floor surfaces of granite accented by hardwood trimmed lobby walls complete the finishing touches of this architectural achievement.
